needed to learn how to handle a faster twin engine intruder and to fly at low level against the odds both the aircraft and their crews delivered mosquito intruders target burma uses diaries first hand accounts and official records to take the reader through the mosquito intruders three year campaign to help force the japanese out of burma living and dying with the brave warriors in the five squadrons which flew the fb vi the first operations were flown by 27 squadron led by the renowned wing commander james nicolson vc the only person in raf fighter command to be awarded the victoria cross during the second world war many of the airmen like the author s father who flew mossie intruder ops with both 27 and 45 squadrons felt that they were forgotten by the public back home and often by their own high command but importantly they knew that their actions were shortening the war in the far east
