assigning username and passwords for clients who pay but prefer online counseling as opposed to face to face counseling the system allows staff to book clients remotely online via secure log in the clients counseled can have their progress tracked easily via the secure counseling chat system i stuck to the usdp process and working on each workflow and resultant artifacts like unified modeling language diagrams to ensure the project was well modeled to be realized in construction and transition phases
